

Prize award Of the 2nd Industrial Design International Competition

The company DROMEAS, one of the biggest exporting companies globally and pioneers in the field of furniture design, organized again the prize award of the 2nd Industrial Design International Competition, on Friday 5 November 2004 at 20:30pm in the Cultural Centre DAIS (Mesogeion str. 151, Institutes DOUKAS, Paradisos Amarousiou). This event was presented by the actor Renos Charalambidis and the prizes would be awarded to the winners by the Minister of Development Dimitris Sioufas.

The company DROMEAS after the first successful organisation and award of the first Industrial Design Prizes in 2002 in Thessalonica, it decided to move on the performance per two years of notice of similar competition, in order to demonstrate new talents from around the world and to establish the prizes as an institution in the sector.

The notice of the 2nd Industrial Design International Competition took place in 2003 and the submitted proposals from around the world reached the 219. A special committee evaluated the submitted projects and awarded the prizes as follows:

1st prize and cash prize of 10.000 € Alexandros Didaskalou, for 'PC working desk'.

2nd prize and cash prize of 5.000€ Designing group (DPSD 2000) of students of the Engineers Designing Products and Systems department of the Aegean University (in Syros) for the desks 'Quadriga and Flow'. The team is composed by Aspasia Anifantaki, Fivos Vogiatzis, Giota Vaia, Dimitrios Gotsis, Constantinos Goutzamanis, Maria Grigoriadou, Chrisanthi Dimareli, Kalirroï – Maria Ioakimidou, Dimitrios Ioannou, Georgios Kanelopoulos, Georgios Karafotias, Dionisis Klavdianos, Maria Koutsouna, Georgios Kothonis, Ioanna Pappa, Kalliopi Peponi, Panagiota Skirianou and Michail Fthenos.

The 3rd prize and cash prize of 3.000€ Peter SA Walker for the 'archive with wheels Tracktor'.

Praise and cash prize of 1.500€ in the Designing Group (DPSD 2000) of students of the Engineers Designing Products and Systems department of the Aegean University (in Syros) for the composition 'working stations Wing, Alt + View and Copertura'.

Praise and cash prize of 1.500€ to Filippos Zannettos for the levitating waiting chair, 'The Playground'

Praise and cash prize of 1.500€ to Andreas Struppler (Germany) for 'desk, partition, composition of desks and bookcases'.

In parallel with the prize award in the Cultural Centre DAIS was also functioned an exhibition with the compositions of all the participants.
