«Meeting of Deputy Foreign Minister of Germany with young entrepreneurs from Northern Greece at the premises of DROMEAS»

On Thursday, October 24 2014, DROMEAS hosted in its premises in Thessaloniki a meeting of Michael Roth, the Deputy Foreign Minister of the Federal Republic of Germany, Dr. Schoof, the Ambassador of the Federal Republic of Germany and Dr. von Voss, Consul General, with a group of young entrepreneurs in Northern Greece, representing the branches of building materials, chemical products, furniture, tourism, real estate, web development, and event management. The meeting was organized by the Greek-German Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

Mr. Roth has encouraged the entrepreneurs to continue their arduous path with additional enthusiasm.
